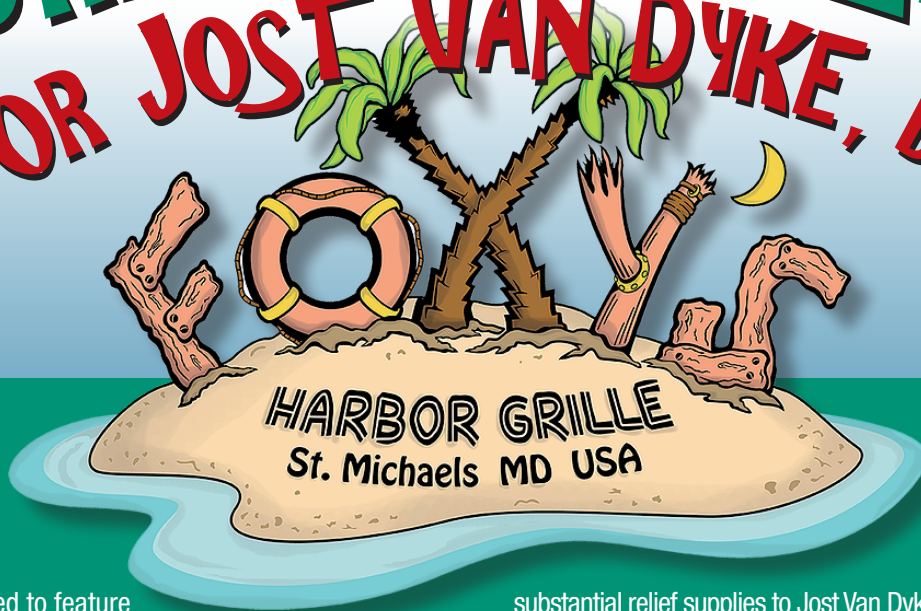


HURRICANE RELIEF FOR JOST VAN DYKE, BVI'S



We had planned to feature the legendary entertainer, Foxy Callwood, at our four "Caribbean Nights" Shows Sept. 12 and 13th here at Foxy's Harbor Grille. Hurricane Irma made an unexpected turn on Sunday, Sept. 3rd and headed for the northern Leeward Islands including Barbuda, St. Barts and St. Martin before slamming into the British Virgin Islands. There was almost total destruction on some of these islands with Jost Van Dyke taking a "direct hit" on Wednesday. Foxy and his wife were trapped on the island along with hundreds of people. We got word yesterday that "Foxy and his family are safe" - but we are unable to gain direct communications.

They will not be able to get out of the BVI's for many weeks, and Foxy's assistant who manages the "Jost Van Dyke Preservation Society" founded many years ago by Foxy has requested via email that we push forward and raise funds for emergency relief as they lack proper shelter, drinkable water, food, etc. This charity or foundation is ideally suited to manage the delivery of relief supplies quickly as the BVI Government may take many weeks to provide

substantial relief supplies to Jost Van Dyke. The funds generated by our ticket sales (*less expenses for the band, etc.*) will go directly to the JVD Preservation Society marked for immediate Hurricane Relief supplies. This charity is an IRS approved 501 (c)(3) tax exempt foundation, and your tax deductible gift can be claimed on your 2017 tax return.

We urge you to "dig deep" and help us let them know we really care about their plight as they struggle to get "back on their feet" and start to rebuild. We will send 4-5 person work crews down next year when they can support these crews, but in the near term they need money. All donations to the "Jost Van Dyke Preservation Society" will receive a proper receipt for your tax records. Tim Duncan, the star basketball player who retired from the San Antonio Spurs, announced that he would provide "matching funds" up to \$1M for hurricane relief efforts for the Virgin Islands.
